



Cluster 1: Health: Call - Tackling disease (Single stage - 2024)

Deadline: 26 November 2024

Topic	SSH aspects
HORIZON-HLTH-2024-DISEASE-13-01 Implementation research for management of multiple long-term conditions in the context of non-communicable diseases (Global Alliance for Chronic Diseases - GACD)	The topic is focused on implementation research for management of multiple long-term conditions in the context of NCDs (MLTC NCD) in LMICs and/or disadvantaged populations in HICs. Proposals should focus on implementation science around interventions that will generate evidence about when, for whom, and under what circumstances, patient-centred approaches can improve integrated care for patients with MLTC NCD.
<u>Link</u>	Applicants must explore the implementation of proposed intervention(s) for a selected study population(s) taking into account the unique social, political, economic, and cultural context(s) in which the study will take place. Main keywords: Sociology, Political Science, Economics



Cluster 3: Civil Security for Society: Call - Fighting Crime and Terrorism 2024 Deadline: 20 November 2024

Topic	SSH aspects
HORIZON-CL3-2024-FCT-01-03 Lawful evidence collection in online child sexual abuse investigations, including undercover Link	Research in this area should tackle legislative frameworks to collecting evidence in online, including undercover, investigations of child sexual abuse, leading to guidelines and manuals that would make the capability available across the EU to target these offenders more effectively. Special care needs to be given to ethics and fundamental rights protection throughout the research and the solutions proposed. This topic requires the effective contribution of SSH disciplines and the involvement of SSH experts, institutions as well as the inclusion of relevant SSH expertise, in order to produce meaningful and significant effects enhancing the societal impact of the related innovation activities. Main keywords: Law, Criminology, Ethics
HORIZON-CL3-2024-FCT-01-04 Radicalisation and gender Link	In order to improve understandings of radicalization and gender we need to study how and why gender norms appear as an increasingly contested area of politics with strong mobilizing power. What role gender norms and equality policies play in stabilizing and destabilizing social and political order, and how ideas and norms about gender equality make people react, mobilize and engage politically, at present, in the past and in the future. Proposals should recognise not only the cultural, social and economic diversity of the milieus, but as mentioned above also be gender sensitive. This topic requires the effective contribution of SSH disciplines and the involvement of SSH experts, institutions as well as the inclusion of relevant SSH expertise, in order to produce meaningful and significant effects enhancing the societal impact of the related innovation activities. Main keywords: Political Science, Social and Cultural studies, Economics, Ethics, Gender studies
HORIZON-CL3-2024-FCT-01-05 Combating hate speech online and offline Link	The successful proposal is expected to reinforce hate crime training and capacity building for Police Authorities and other relevant security practitioners, in particular to enhance their tools and methods for lawful detection, reporting and data/evidence collection and analysis of the hate speech related activities that are considered as crime or could lead to a crime. Activities proposed within this topic should address, in a balanced way, both technological and societal dimensions of the issue under consideration. This topic requires the effective contribution of SSH disciplines and the involvement of SSH experts, institutions as well as the inclusion of relevant SSH expertise, in order to produce meaningful and significant effects enhancing the societal impact of the related innovation activities. Main keywords: Law, Sociology, Education, Communication studies



Cluster 4: Digital, Industry and Space: Call - A human-centred and ethical development of digital and

industrial technologies

HORIZON-CL4-2024-HUMAN-03-02 Explainable and Robust AI (AI Data and Robotics Partnership) Link	 Multidisciplinary research activities should address all of the following: Proposals should involve appropriate expertise in all the relevant sector specific use cases and disciplines, and where appropriate Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH), including gender and intersectional knowledge to address concerns around gender, racial or other biases, etc. Proposals are expected to dedicate tasks and resources to collaborate with and provide input to the open innovation challenge under HORIZON-CL4-2023-HUMAN-01-04 addressing explainability and robustness. Research teams involved in the proposals are expected to participate in the respective Innovation Challenges. Contribute to making Al and robotics solutions meet the requirements of Trustworthy Al, based on the respect of the ethical principles, the fundamental rights including critical aspects such as robustness, safety, reliability, in line with the European Approach to Al. Ethics principles needs to be adopted from early stages of development and design. Main keywords: Sociology, Gender studies, Ethics
HORIZON-CL4-2024-HUMAN-03-03 Digital Humanism - Putting people at the centre of the digital transformation Link	The topic requires intense, cross-disciplinary work of computer (and technology) sciences with legal, economic, sociological, philosophical and other kinds of expertise as a co-development exercise. To support in-depth, early-on collaboration between computer sciences and the whole wealth of humanities and social sciences to put new algorithms and models into a broader context, proposals under this topic should support the development of an active network and cross disciplinary communities on digital humanism bringing together ICT experts, ethnologists, sociologists and experts in fundamental rights. Main keywords: Law, Economics, Sociology, Philosophy, Ethnology, Political Science

HORIZON-CL5-2024-D3-02-06 Innovative, Community-Integrated PV systems <u>Link</u>	This topic requires the effective contribution of Social Science and Humanities (SSH) disciplines and the involvement of SSH experts, institutions as well as the inclusion of relevant SSH expertise, in order to produce meaningful and significant effects enhancing the societal impact of the related research activities. Social innovations should also be considered, notably as new tools, ideas and methods leading to active citizen engagement and as drivers of social change, social ownership, and new social practices.		
HORIZON-CL5-2024-D3-02-10 Market Uptake Measures of renewable energy	Main keywords: Social innovation The complexity of the challenges and of the related market uptake barriers may call for multi-disciplinary approaches, which requires contributions from the social sciences and humanities. Where relevant, local, regional		
ink	specificities, socio-economic, gender-related, spatial and environmental aspects will be considered from a life-cycle perspective. Proposals are encouraged to address social acceptability through the assessment of the environmental economic and social impacts associated with the development of these renewable energies and through the adequate involvement of stakeholders in decision-making processes.		
	This topic requires the effective contribution of SSH disciplines and the involvement of SSH experts, institutions as well as the inclusion of relevant SSH expertise, in order to produce meaningful and significant effects for understanding and addressing societal barriers to the uptake of renewable energy systems. Where relevant, proposals are expected to also assess the legal, institutional, and political frameworks at local, national and European level and examine how, why and under what conditions these could act as a barrier or an enabler.

HORIZON-CL6-2024-CLIMATE-02-3 Overcoming barriers and delivering innovative solutions to enable the green transition Link	 Proposals funded under this topic should: identify barriers to the uptake by end users of new knowledge and innovation for the green transition on aspects of water resilience, circular economy, biodiversity, zero pollution, and climate change; address factors (socio-economic, cultural, etc.) that differ across the EU and play a fundamental role in determining the acceptance of technological and social innovation solutions designed to foster the green transition; develop solutions to overcome identified barriers, including by taking advantage of technological and digital tools as well as innovative dissemination strategies, organisational models and educational activities. The involvement of actors as appropriate, based on the elements of the multi-actor approach, is encouraged. This topic requires the effective contribution of SSH disciplines and the involvement of SSH experts, institutions as well as the inclusion of relevant SSH expertise, in order to produce meaningful and significant effects enhancing the societal impact of the related innovation activities. 
